Voluntary Actions:

The origin of the action is with the agent With knowledge of the circumstances Not under compulsion

Non Voluntary

Ignorance with no subsequent "Pain & Repentance"

Involuntary

Ignorance of the <u>particulars</u>, and causing subsequent "Pain & Repentance"

Notes:

Done <u>through</u> ignorance e.g. of the particulars ("Circumstances & Objects of the action")

Done <u>in</u> Ignorance, e.g. drunk see p123 (III4a)

We should not be ignorant of the "Universal" or of the law.
